## NEW TOURS FOR 2010!

Every Saturday at 11am you are invited to join us on one of our four new tours at Arnos Vale Cemetery. Costing just £5 per person (£3 concessions and children) they will start from the East Lodge along the Bath Road entrance. Please arrive ten minutes prior to the start time to complete the administration process and ensure that you wear sensible shoes for the tours. Dogs are also welcome provided they are friendly and kept on a lead at all times (dogs not allowed on the Wildlife Tours).

### Ceremonial Way Tour

This tour takes a leisurely route around the 'ceremonial way', a wide flat graveled road in the immediate area of the cemetery. On the way you will stop at graves to hear about those buried there or to talk about monuments themselves and the carvings on them. This walk should take about an hour and is suitable for everyone no matter what their ability.

### Boundaries Tour

This tour explores the cemetery's historic boundaries and areas of expansion. This is the longest of the walks, covering the most ground, and involves some steep paths and steps. On the way you will stop at graves to hear about those buried there or to talk about monuments themselves and the carvings on them. This walk should take about an hour and is not suitable for those with difficulty walking.

### Woodland Tour

This tour concentrates on the wooded 'amphitheatre' that sweeps around from the behind the Anglican chapel and beyond the Non-conformist chapel and will take you along some grass and muddy paths and gentle slopes. On the way you will stop at graves to hear about those buried there or to talk about monuments themselves and the carvings on them. This walk should take about an hour and is not suitable for those with difficulty walking due to the nature of the uneven ground covered.

### Wildlife Tour

This tour will cover some muddy paths, slopes and steps, to find the seasonal highlights of wild life in Arnos Vale at this time of year talking about animals, birds, insects and flora/fauna. As the seasons change so will the topics covered so there is always something new to discover. On the way you will also stop at graves to hear about those buried there or to talk about monuments themselves and the carvings on them. This walk will take just over an hour and is not suitable for those with difficulty walking due to the nature of the ground covered.
