Three planning applications threaten the mature trees and green space on Bedminster Green. They are:

21/05219/F | Plot 5 Bedminster Green, Hereford Street, Clarke Street, Whitehouse Lane, Bristol BS3 4NA made by Dandara to build housing that will remove at least **13 individual trees, groups and hedgerow to be removed in full or part.*** If Dandara get planning permission there is a plan to sell them Bedminster Green.
**Bristol Tree Forum think this number is higher at 37 trees.*



23/00611/FB | Proposed restoration of a section of the River Malago made by Bristol City Council to open up the Malago. A minimum of **17 individual trees, groups and hedgerows**** to be removed in full or part.
***Bristol Tree Forum think this number is higher at 25 trees.*



23/02915/F | Installation of underground pipework and associated works to form part of district heat network made by Vattenfall Heat UK Ltd. At least **3 trees** are to be removed.
